There are three main options for fellowship training in Pulmonary and/or Critical Care Medicine. 1. Combined Pulmonary and Critical Care Training Programs: These programs require a total of 3 years training, with at least 18 months of clinical training (6 pulmonary, 6 critical care and 6 combined). Up to 18 months of research may be part of the fellowship training, and many programs
