Lesson 16 ALGEBRA 1 Solve this equation by graphing two functions on the same Cartesian plane: $10.5x - 5$ and $lx - 31 + 4$ Let $f(x) = 10.5x - 5$ and $g(x) = lx - 31 + 4$ where x can be any real number. We looking for values of x at which the functions f and g have the same output value.

Lesson 16 Notes (Solving Systems Graphically)

Solve systems of two linear equations in two variables algebraically, and estimate solutions by graphing the equations. Solve simple cases by inspection. For example, $3x + 2y = 5$ and $3x + 2y = 6$ have no solution because $3x + 2y$ cannot simultaneously be 5 and 6.

Lesson 16: Solve Systems of Equations Algebraically ...

1. $3x + 4y = 12$; $6x + 8y = -16$ (A: Parallel lines, no solution, inconsistent) 2. $9x - 6y = 24$; $6x - 4y = 16$ (A: ∞ solutions; same line, Consistent and independent.) 3. $2x + y = 5$; $x - y = 1$ (A: One solution (2,1); consistent and dependent). Have $y = 15x - 100$ $y = 3x + 38.5$ Subtract $0 = 12x - 138.5$
