Recognizing the need to incorporate the patient's voice in reporting of treatment-related toxicity, researchers have proven the value of giving patients editorial control over the process by incorporating validated instruments, generally referred to as patient-reported outcomes (PROs) in their design of trial protocols.

Therefore, it is critically important to incorporate the principle of optimizing perioperative medical care by using a fast-track recovery paradigm in future studies examining the impact of pain management on patient outcomes . Well-controlled and appropriately powered clinical studies which examine the impact of improved analgesic techniques on patient comfort, quality of recovery, and resumption of normal activities of daily living (i.e., fast-track recovery) are probably of greater ...
